University Ave:

- A request was made to obtain a quote to replace the broken junction box cover plates. The quote was received for an amount within the limit identified at the April committee meeting. A work order was then issued to proceed.
- A previously removed tree grate that was in storage was reinstalled at the corner of Illinois St.
- The approved lava rock for the holes at the tree grates has been installed.

El Cajon Blvd

- The approved planting project has been completed.
- The approved mulching of the medians is to begin the week of 5/14.
- The circuit of lights between Kansas St. and Ohio St. is now working.
- A request was made to plant two trees in round tree wells at El Cajon Blvd. and Iowa St.

30th Street:

- Urban Corps has continued pumping out the excess water where new trees were planted. It appears that the pumping is working. All new trees are now flushing out with new leaves.

Boundary Street:

- The approved solar light has been installed.
- The sub contractor for Caltrans has begun the work for the area along the border fence.

Miscellaneous:

- A lighting inspection has been completed and the results have been submitted to the Streets Department via the City's Get It Done app.
- GET-IT-DONE is a valuable tool for reporting many City issues. This form of reporting helps the issue get referred to the correct department to address. I encourage everyone to become familiar with GET-IT-DONE which is available on the City homepage at www.sandiego.gov or available as an application for smartphones.
- A quote for \$5,943.50 has been received to replace solar light #8, located at 4170 Alabama St.
