University Ave:

- A work order has been issued to trim the trees and separate them from the buildings in the North Park Main Street areas. Coordination between NPMS and the City is occurring to have the twinkle lights removed so that the trees can be trimmed. NPMS will rewrap the trees when the work is completed.
- A work order has been issued to have the large MAD trees trimmed away from the businesses outside of the North Park Main Street areas.

El Cajon Blvd

- The approved mulching project has been completed.
- The scheduled fertilization of the medians has been completed.
- The watering for all the newly planted medians is being monitored to insure the new plants are receiving sufficient water.
- A work order was issued to plant two new trees at 3095 El Cajon Blvd.
- A work order was issued to trim the large eucalyptus trees that are not the responsibility of the City's Street Department.

30th Street:

- A work has been issued to have the large MAD trees trimmed away from the businesses.
- The light post between University Ave and El Cajon Blvd., have been frequently graffitied. They will be cleaned and repainted.

Miscellaneous:

- A light inspection has been completed and the results have been submitted to the Streets Department via the City's Get It Done app.
- A work order has been issued to have the approved solar light installed at Alabama St. The light will be installed before the end of June.
