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**University Ave:**

- A work order has been put in to have the damaged and missing tiles installed. The tile has been ordered and will be installed as soon as it comes in.
- The new trash enclosure at Alabama St. has been installed.
- Urban Corps has begun to weed whip unmaintained easements at the west end.

**El Cajon Blvd**

- The Boulevard sign has been repaired. The “the” and “V” are now working. However, there is a small section at the bottom of the “t” of the “the” that needs to be replaced. The part is on order and will be replaced as soon as it comes in.
- Urban Corps continuing to address the weeds germinating after the recent rains.
- There have been issues with the trash enclosures not being emptied according to the schedule. I’ve had to follow up each week informing ESD to resolve. Continuing to monitor.

**30th Street**

- Urban Corps and myself continue to pump water from the tree basins. There has been continual water from recent storms.
- A work order has been issued to grind the stump and replace the tree that fell over at 4026.

**Grim Ave**

- 3812 Tree that died during the winter is scheduled to be replace.

**Miscellaneous:**

- A light inspection has been completed and the results have been submitted to the Streets Department via the City’s Get It Done app.
- I’m continuing to report pot holes via the Get it Done app.
- A PO request has been submitted for the Anne Mudge project. When approved, Urban Corps will begin the work.
