**University Ave:**

- There are a few new missing tiles in the red sidewalks that are scheduled to be replaced before the end of June.
- There has been a rash of vandalism, particularly in the Main Street area. For about two weeks someone had been taking the trash cans out of the receptacles and either placed them on top, next to it or moved throughout the MAD.
- The twinkles lights on the MAD electrical circuits were also vandalized on different occasions. At this time North Park Main Street has decided to hold off on repairs. Therefore, I have turned off the circuit breakers.

**El Cajon Blvd**

- All medians have been fertilized.
- The weed issue has improved tremendously, and the medians are looking good.
- The Jacarandas Trees are blooming nicely. This will create extra debris along the medians. Urban Corps is aware that extra attention will be necessary to keep clean.
- ESD has continued to do a much better job in emptying their trash enclosures. No calls, text or emails were necessary this last month.

**30th Street**

- Urban Corps and myself continue to pump water from the tree basins and sweep the water from the gutters. There has been continual water even after the rains have diminished.
- The bottoms of the light posts have been repeatedly tagged with marking pens. Urban Corps is aware and has been painting over every week.

**Grim Ave**

- The tree at 3812 was replaced, but also died. Urban Corps has replaced the tree at their cost.

**Miscellaneous:**

- A light inspection has been completed and the results have been submitted to the Streets Department via the City's Get It Done app.
- I'm continuing to report pot holes via the Get it Done app.
- The Anne Mudge renovation project is scheduled to begin June 10.

- A new request for quote for power washing was out for FY 2020. The quotes were received and the MAD will have a new power washing company. The new company will be Southbay Power Washing. Southbay Power Washing will begin on July 1, 2019.
- **Topic for discussion:** A member of the community has contacted us regarding the possibility of adding trash enclosures in areas around the community.
