**University Ave:**

- I met with the PBID, their power washing contractor and the MAD's power washing contractor to look at the areas where services occur. We discussed the work provided, what was expected and made sure that schedules are synched to provide the best services for everyone.

**El Cajon Blvd**

- There was an issue with ESD missing one of their pick-ups. Text and phone calls were made. They did their next pick-up according to schedule and came back the following day for any new trash before the weekend.
- A request was made to ESD to replace the broken trash enclosure at the NW Kansas St. corner. Another request was made to repair or replace the trash enclosure at the SW corner of Utah St. where the enclosure is missing the door. The supervisor said that he'll get them scheduled.
- Urban Corps cleaned up large stains from spills where trash enclosures were too full.
- There continues to be excessive leaf drop from the eucalyptus trees all along El Cajon Blvd. Urban Corps continuing to provide extra clean up where necessary.

**30<sup>th</sup> Street**

- The crape myrtles near Upas St. are looking black due to the amount of flower pollen mixed with the road dust and debris from the new pipeline project. Health wise they're doing fine

**Meade Ave**

- The low branches on the cassia trees were lifted to prevent obstruction of the sidewalks.

**Miscellaneous:**

- A light inspection has been completed and the results have been submitted to the Streets Department via the City's Get It Done app.
- Action Item – Quote to refurbish the North Park sign. Work to include repainting of the sign, neon repair, replacement of the clear plex faces and to clean, polish and seal the stainless steel and tile base. Total amount is \$8,220.00
