**University Ave**

- Urban Corps has changed the supervisor for the North Park MAD. This occurred after several discussions with their leadership. So far, it appears the change is going well.
- The tile work has been completed. Everything went well other than running out of tile. This was due to me asking them to take out the non-matching tile if it was adjacent an area that needed to be repaired.
- The power washing has been burdened with additional clean ups. Urban Corps has done well at handling these tasks.

**El Cajon Blvd**

- Urban Corps continues to improve in completing all task for the area.
- Urban Corps will be spreading new mulch in conjunction with their regular task.

**30<sup>th</sup> Street**

- The repaving of the area went well. The area looks cleaner now and I have spoken to Urban Corps about keeping that way. One issue is the asphalt gravel on driveways and sidewalk edges. This will need to be swept up and removed. Urban Corps is aware and will address.

**Boundary Street**

- The homeless having tried taking over the area along the 805 freeway. Caltrans has been removing encampments and our crews have been removing the additional trash. We will continue to monitor.

**Miscellaneous:**

- A lighting inspection was completed, and all non-working lights were submitted via the Get it Done app.
- The solar lights on Idaho St and Florida St have been replaced. This concludes the replacement of all twelve solar lights.
