**University Ave**

- Urban Corps continues to be a good job with the power washing. The City Tacos and Encontro areas are being degreased before service weekly due to an increase in foot traffic.
- Two trash enclosures at the corner of 29<sup>th</sup> St and University Ave have been relocated to allow the new business an opportunity for outside dining.

**El Cajon Blvd**

- There is currently a lot of trash and leaf litter being addressed. The leaf litter should taper off as the eucalyptus stop shedding old leaves.

**30<sup>th</sup> Street**

- The bike corrals (2) were removed during the repaving. I reached out to the project manager and he informed me they should be at the Chollas yard. I will have them relocated to another City yard that the MAD uses for future use.

**Boundary Street**

- The homelessness continues to be an issue in this area. They are currently setting up on the 805 side of the fence, but we are removing a lot of trash from the MAD side. Urban Corps has been asked to pay extra attention to the area.
- The Anne Mudge area was heavily graffitied. Urban Corps had to repaint instead of clean due to the large amount of area hit.

**Miscellaneous:**

- A lighting inspection was completed, and all non-working lights were submitted via the Get it Done app.
- The “the” of the Boulevard sign stopped working during the rains. It began working a couple of days later and needs no further work.
- I’ve spoken to the PBID about possible tree work on Ray St. Angie is reaching out to the property owners for their opinions.
