University Ave

- Urban Corps continues to do a good job with the power washing. The homeless situation is still an issue for them, but they do their best in working around them. The worst area currently is the block between Kansas St and the alley to the west.

El Cajon Blvd

- The fertilization of all medians has been completed.
- A work order has been submitted to have the MAD's eucalyptus trees trimmed.
- The new trash enclosures have been ordered. Two are on back order and the remaining four are being powder coated. When they are ready Urban Corps will pick up, deliver, and install.

Rav Street

- The tree replacement project has been completed. There were a couple of hiccups due to the contractor showing up a day earlier than anticipated.
- Some of the old tree cages were in bad condition. Some were rusted and two others were removed with the trees still inside due to the trees growing through them.
- A request has been made to have the existing trash enclosures painted different colors. I provided a palette of available colors to those interested. Once a decision is made and with the consent of the committee, I will proceed to have the work completed.

Meade Ave

- Urban Corps is lightly trimming up the low branches from the cassia trees. The seed pods are causing them to droop too low for pedestrians on the sidewalks.

Miscellaneous:

- A lighting inspection was completed, and all non-working lights were submitted via the Get it Done app.
- The "D" in the Boulevard sign is scheduled to be repaired soon.
